I will attend the Rutgers - New Brunswick Summer Session **this summer** to raise my cumulative average to the required standard stated in the enclosed letter in order to avoid academic dismissal effective for the upcoming fall semester. If I am unable to raise my cumulative GPA to the required standard for my class year during the Rutgers Summer Session (check one):

this would constitute my **dismissal**. I understand it is the policy of the School of Arts and Sciences that students who receive an academic dismissal are not eligible for readmission to Rutgers for any future semester.

Readmission – Option for Suspension only

I have not been previously suspended. Important Information

If you plan to enroll in classes this summer, please return this form **no later than the final day of Summer Session Classes** so the Scholastic Standing Deans are aware of your intent to continue. **Your Fall courses will be cancelled if you are unable to achieve the required grade-point average stated in your letter of Suspension or Dismissal by the end of Summer Session.**

Things to consider:

- Your primary goal in completing summer course work is to raise your cumulative GPA and earn back your enrollment eligibility for the Fall. Choose a reasonable Summer schedule. Avoid difficult courses or trying to “catch up” on credits.
- If you take extra courses beyond those required to earn back your enrollment eligibility, keep in mind that **all** Summer grades will be counted in determining whether you have achieved the required GPA for Fall enrollment eligibility.
- Choose summer classes in your academic strength areas, with meeting times that will make it convenient for you to attend punctually and faithfully. Limit summer work hours and commitments so you have time to focus on course work.
- You are being asked to finish summer course work successfully and on time. If you are not able to accomplish this and as a result your Summer grades are late, incomplete or missing, your Suspension or Dismissal for the Fall will stand. We strongly recommend you register for Summer Session I or II, to insure you have time to deal with last-minute issues that might otherwise prevent your grades from being posted by the **end of Summer Session** deadline.
- Be sure to attend suspension/dismissal advising so you are clear about the Summer requirements you must meet and the best options available to you for earning back your enrollment eligibility.
- Students who have received a **Suspension** have the option of waiting until a future Summer Session to complete the required readmission course work. Taking an academic year off may be a better option for students who are resolving serious long-term issues related to health or personal wellbeing. Students who have received a **Dismissal** have only the Summer immediately following Dismissal to remediate their cumulative GPA to the required level.
- The School of Arts and Sciences Faculty Committee on Academic Standing will not accept poor planning, failure to contact SAS staff to inquire about University resources, or any interference from a job as excuses for poor academic performance. Please plan your Summer carefully.
- Payment of your Summer Term Bill completes your Summer registration.
